

Commercial Lighting

Member Requirements:

- Completes lighting project information
- Completes rebate application
- Provide copy of invoice with make, model, quantity
- Provide make & model of LEDS or LED specs to verify qualification
- Save document before submitting

Information:

- Change out lights that are not already LED to LED
- Rebate is determined by the lighting calculator
 - EPR team (or their designee) or vendor can complete OTEC's calculator
- Rebate is sent as a check to the member once all the paperwork is received and approved
- Buy local rebate is 10% of the project cost up to \$50 if rebate qualifies
- This is a BPA rebate

Location = Room name or type. Examples are John's office, private office, open office, bathroom, etc

Quantity existing = how many light fixtures (if multiple types, each type will need its own line)

Type of existing fixture = troffers with 3 tube T8 size bulbs or 65 watt incandescent bulb, or 2 tube strip fixture 8ft bulbs T12 (T12 size bulbs are about 1 inch, T8 are about 3/4 inch and T5 are about 1/2 inch.

Hours lights are on per day = are they on 8 hours a day 5 days a week 52 weeks a year? or 1/2 hour a day 1 day a month?

What type of heating and cooling for each location? Electric, gas, propane, oil, wood? For cooling is a heat pump, central, window, no cooling, etc.
